

VHP-sponsored bandh disrupts normal life in Assam



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A 12 hour country wide Bharat bandh is disrupting normal life in Assam on Thursday along with other states. Sponsored by Viswa Hindu Parishah on Amarnath land transfer row, the bandh began at 5 in the morning on Thursday in Assam when all schools, banks and other business establishments remained closed.
