

Victoria case: Doc grilled



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Amid an escalating [controversy over](#) the Victoria suicide, Dispur police grilled a doctor of the International Hospital on Wednesday.

Police summoned Dr Sushil Agarwalla and was interrogated for nearly three hours. He was asked to come again if need be.

Two security [guards](#) were also questioned in this connection. The interrogation assumes significance two days after a section of media revealed that the Meghalaya girl was killed.

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
