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AGARTALA: Counting of votes begins in [Tripura](#) amid unprecedented security measures simultaneously along with [Nagaland](#) and [Meghalaya](#). The initial [trends](#) are available by 10 in the morning where the assembly polling took place in 59 candidates on February 18.

The polling was countermanded in a constituency following the demise of a ruling party candidate.
