

Want ST status or wont remain quiet



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KOKRAJHAR: The Assam Santhali Students Union on Tuesday staged dharna in Kokrajhar raising their demand for granting [ST](#) status.

Nearly 200 Santhali students thronged Kokrajhar and staged a two hour long demonstration raising a slew of [demands](#) in front of Kokrajhar DC Office premises.

Talking to Assam Times the protesting [leaders](#) said, "without [ST](#) status it would be difficult for them to progress. We want [ST](#) status to be uplifted. If ignored we have no option but to launch a statewide agitation."

Later, they submitted a memorandum to Chief Minister through the Kokrajhar DC highlighting their long standing [demands](#).

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
