

Who is Rome Neog in Arunachal?



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Romeo [Neog](#), the name of a person from Assam seems to have taken the centre stage of political storm in [Arunachal](#) Pradesh.

But who is he? What is he? Where is the person? These are the questions that [start](#) dominating the political confabulations in the north eastern [state](#) in the time of an impending political [crisis](#).

Rome's name figures at a complaint pending with the [Itanagar](#) police station. But he is not the target. The legal cell coordinator of the [Arunachal](#) Pradesh [Congress](#) Committee (APCC) Tadar Nanag in the complaint alleged that dissident [leader](#) Kalikho Pul has approached [Neog](#) for money to manage more [Congress](#) MLAs to revolt [against](#) the [chief](#) minister.

Nanag has enclosed the communication details of the former finance minister with [Neog](#), who is an established businessman from Assam.

Nanag claimed to have more circumstantial evidence to substantiate his allegations [against](#) the former minister who has been leading the dissident camp. According to the complaint, "the sole motive of the conspiracy is to dislodge the present [chief](#) minister by creating law and order problem in the [state](#)."

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
