

Why disturbing women varsity?



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NEW DELHI: Assam [Congress MPs](#) staged protest in [New Delhi](#) on Tuesday alleging the BJP-led government's move to cancel the recognition of Assam Women University in Jorhat.

Led by [state Congress](#) president and Rajya Sabha MP Ripun Bora, the [MPs](#) stood in front of the Mahatma [Gandhi](#) statue at the Sansad Bhawan premises in the morning where they raised voice of protest against the move.

They said the Sonowal government in Assam has been trying to downgrade the [varsity](#) to a technical institute much to the utter disappointment of hundreds of girl students who have been pursuing various courses there.

They asked the Centre not to disrupt the [varsity](#)'s status and immediate measures to uplift it. Lok Sabha [MPs Gaurav Gogoi](#) and Sushmita [Dev](#) also participated in the protest.

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
