

Why Siddique shifted to SMCH!



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The Kaimganj district sessions judge strongly questioned the shifting of [Siddique Ahmed](#) during his judicial custody which ended yesterday.

After allowing the former minister to leave the jail on bail, the judge said that the way the former minister was shifted to SMCH from civil hospital is objectionable.

Notably, Ahmed was initially taken to Karimganj Hospital when he complained uneasiness after he was sent to jail.

But when he failed to recover the jail authorities shifted to the SMCH with out any permission.

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
