

Withdraw agri farming tax: KCC to CM



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The Kamrup Chamber of Commerce demands withdrawal of tax on agricultural farming in the soon to be tabled state budget.

The major [demand](#) as steps to encourage the organic farming figured in the pre budget [meeting](#) with Chief Minister, Tarun [Gogoi](#) who is presenting state budget in the assembly on Monday.

[KCC](#) leaders told [Gogoi](#) that the withdrawal of tax on agriculture would will encourage investment in this sector.

[KCC](#) wish [list](#) include cold storage in all the districts. Citing examples in the West Bengal, the [KCC](#) leaders said the neighboring state has over 500 cold storage and in [Assam](#) there is just 17 such storage.

The [meeting](#) stressed potato cultivation on the the river bank of Brahmaputra which remains fertile in between November to March.

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
