World environment day at Raha

Along with the rest of the world “World Environment [\(/taxonomy/term/1668\)](/taxonomy/term/1668) Day” was observed at Raha on Friday with a day long programme in the Raha PWD inspection bungalow premise by Nagaon district administration in association with the local administration. Indigenous tree plantation programme was successfully held with the guest of honour Brajen Das [\(/taxonomy/term/1926\)](/taxonomy/term/1926), ADC, Nagaon , Arabinda Kalita , S P, Nagaon, Utpal Moni Baishya , CO, CRPF , Nagaon, followed by the other invited guests .

In the begining of the programme , Anindita Kashyap , Circle officer (in-charge) , Raha, briefly explained the objectives and importance of the day.
