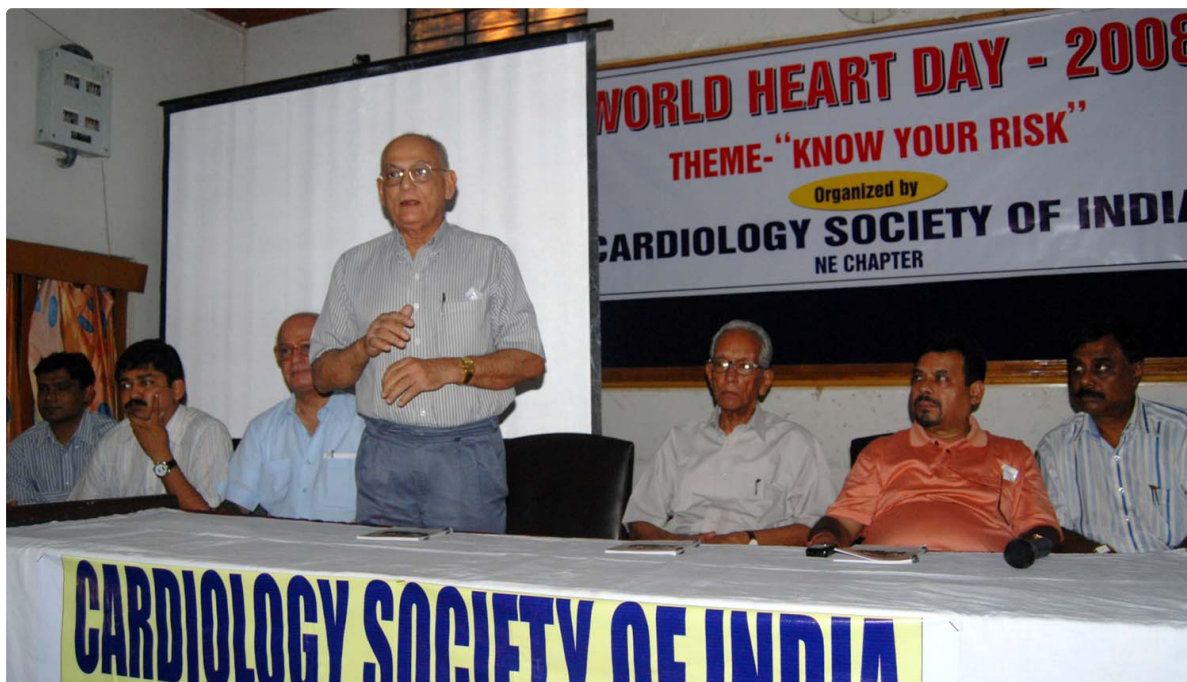


World Heart Day observed in press club
