

YWOA for renewal of peace process

Our Correspondent Guwahati :The Youth Welfare Organisation, Assam (YWOA) has appealed to Assam Government to take positive step for renewal of the peace process with the banned ULFA to bring the outfit to the negotiating table and said dropped process should be once again taken up to be vigorously pursued to its logical and a bold fruitful end.

YWOA president Shyamanta Mahanta in a press release here appealed to the extremists group to put an end to the confrontation with the India Government and come to the negotiating table in the greater interests of the people of Assam.
