

Zeliang to talks to 3 CMs



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Amid simmering allegations [over](#) the Naga peace pact, [Nagaland](#) Chief Minister TR Zeliang said that it is not an accord.

Talking to reporters in [New Delhi](#) on Sunday morning, he said that it is an effort to restore peace and normalcy in north eastern region.
